

Inclement Weather Policy

Weekdays:

Weekday events follow the East Penn School District policies:

If there is an early morning delay then the church office has a delayed opening.

If there is an early dismissal; then no Unity groups or meetings will meet at the church.

Non Unity groups may meet at the leaders' discretion. If you do not hear about what your group plans to do, please contact your leader directly.

The church office will remain closed if school is cancelled for the day and no Unity groups or meetings will meet at the church.

Saturdays:

Weather-related cancellations for scheduled events on a Saturday will be at the discretion of the group / event leader. If you do not hear about what your group plans to do, please contact your leader directly.

Sunday Services:

If we experience severe inclement weather on a Sunday morning, a decision as to whether or not service will be held will be made by the sexton, board president, and minister by 7 am. The office manager will be notified by 7:30 a.m. to submit closure notification to WFMZ, send mass email and update the home page of the website.

If Sunday Service will be canceled, notification will be made in the following ways: WFMZ Channel 69 will scroll closings at the bottom of the TV screen during their programming and will also list closings on their website (<http://www.wfmz.com>). An email notification will be sent to all those on the email list (sign-up on the homepage of our website). The homepage of our website will also be updated with a notification. If the service is canceled, please remember to continue to support ULV with your tithe. Check the website for online donation options or mail your check to the church office.

If the service is not canceled, please use your best judgment and travel safely. Stay at home if you are uncomfortable traveling or if conditions are worse in your area. All Sunday talks will be posted on the ULV website for your listening pleasure.
